

## INFORMATION ON MCIC

1. This course is designed to prepare instructors with the knowledge and skills requires to formally train the combat task of the Marine Corps common skills as defined in MCO 1510.89B. The Marine receives training in coaching skills for individual and crew served weapons and optic, reinforcement of both day and night land navigation, Communications, CPR and First Aid procedures, Combat Marksmanship, Combat Life Savers, Scouting, Patrolling, IED, Guardian Angle, and Convoy Operations.
2. Upon successful completion of MCIC, an 0913 Marine Combat Instructor is capable of performing several jobs here at the School of Infantry. Entry level jobs range from squad leader to company GYSGT.
3. Length of the course: 42 training days (this induces 2 Admin and 5 FSIC days)
4. Maximum class capacity: 40 students
5. Minimum class capacity: 15 students
6. Classes per fiscal year: 4 classes
