Subj: DETACHMENT POLICY FOR PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST (PFT) RUN ROUTES

1. Situation. The reference establishes requirements for approved PFT run routes.

2. Mission. In order to comply with the reference, the detachment will establish designated PFT run routes certified by the Command Physical Training Representative (CPTR).

3. Execution.

a. Commanders's Intent and Concept of Operations. My intent is to comply with the reference and establish PFT run routes certified by the Detachment CPTR. I expect safe transportation methods and operational risk management (ORM) to be applied during movement to and from all PFT run routes and during the conduct of all PFTs.

b. Tasks.

(1) Command Physical Training Representative (CPTR). The enclosures will be the four approved PFT run routes for this Detachment. Measure, mark, and certify those four run routes.

(2) Company Commanders/School Directors. Use one of the approved PFT run routes (enclosures 1-4) for the conduct of your official PFTs.

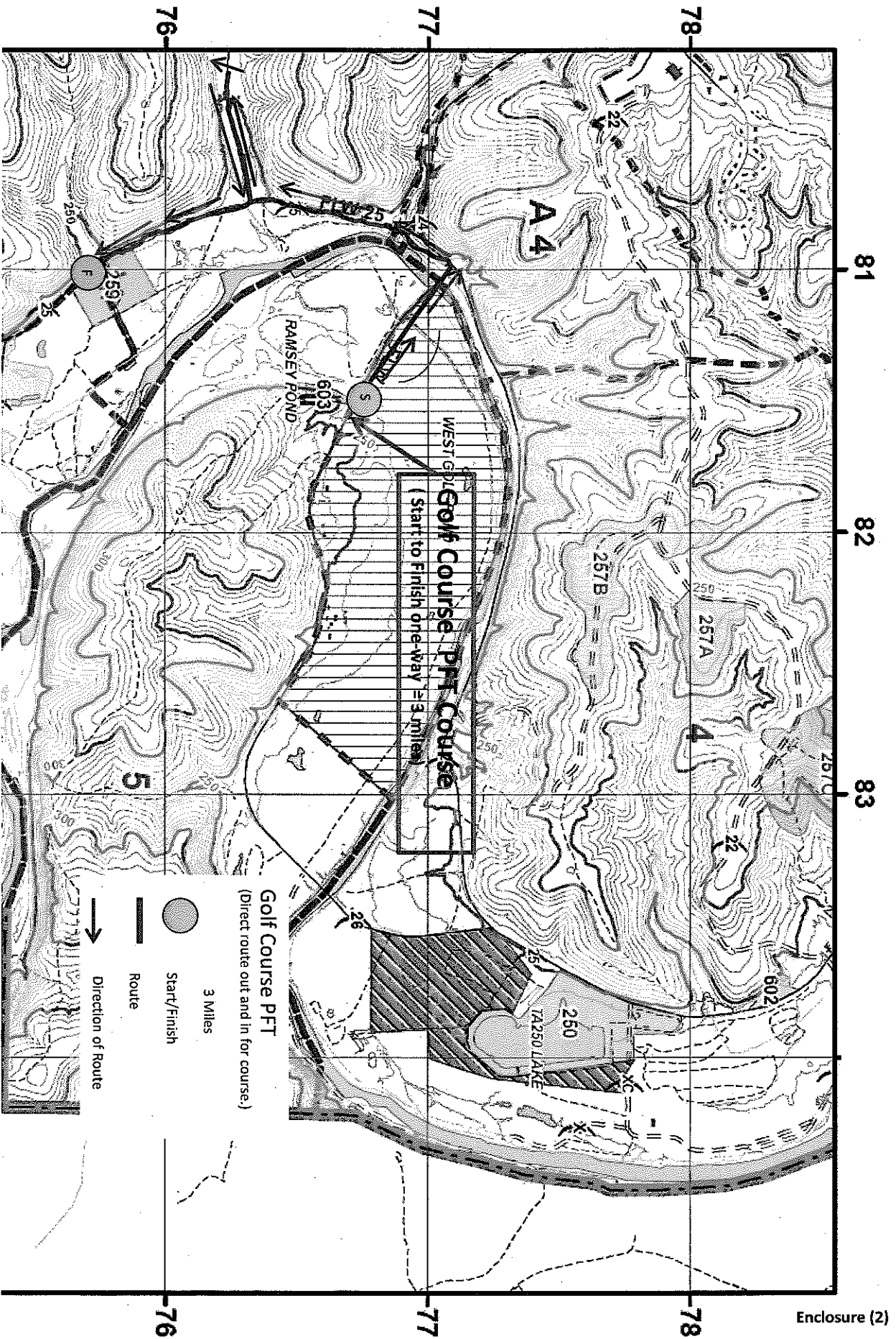
4. Administration and Logistics. Follow the procedures in the reference and this policy letter.

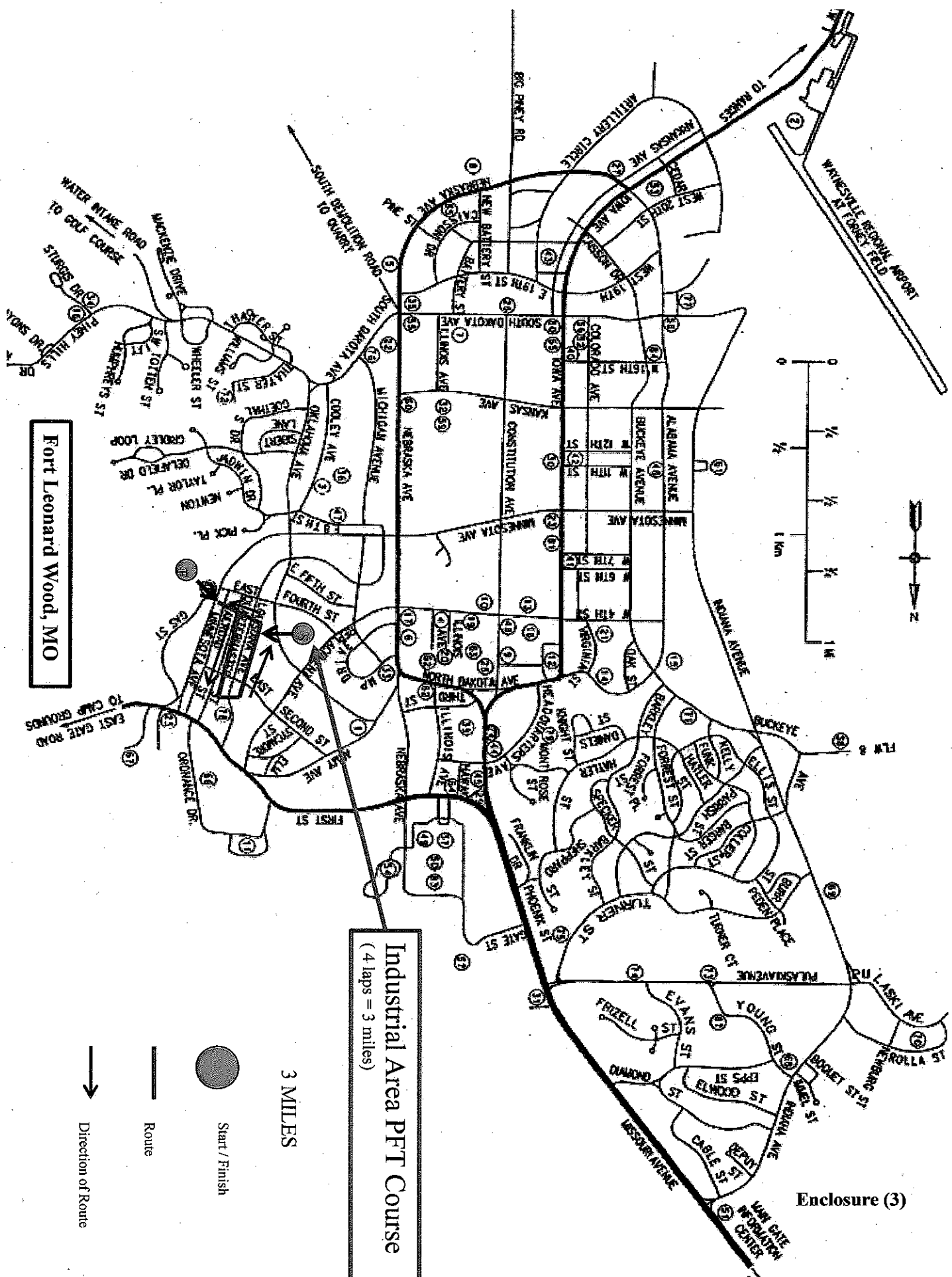

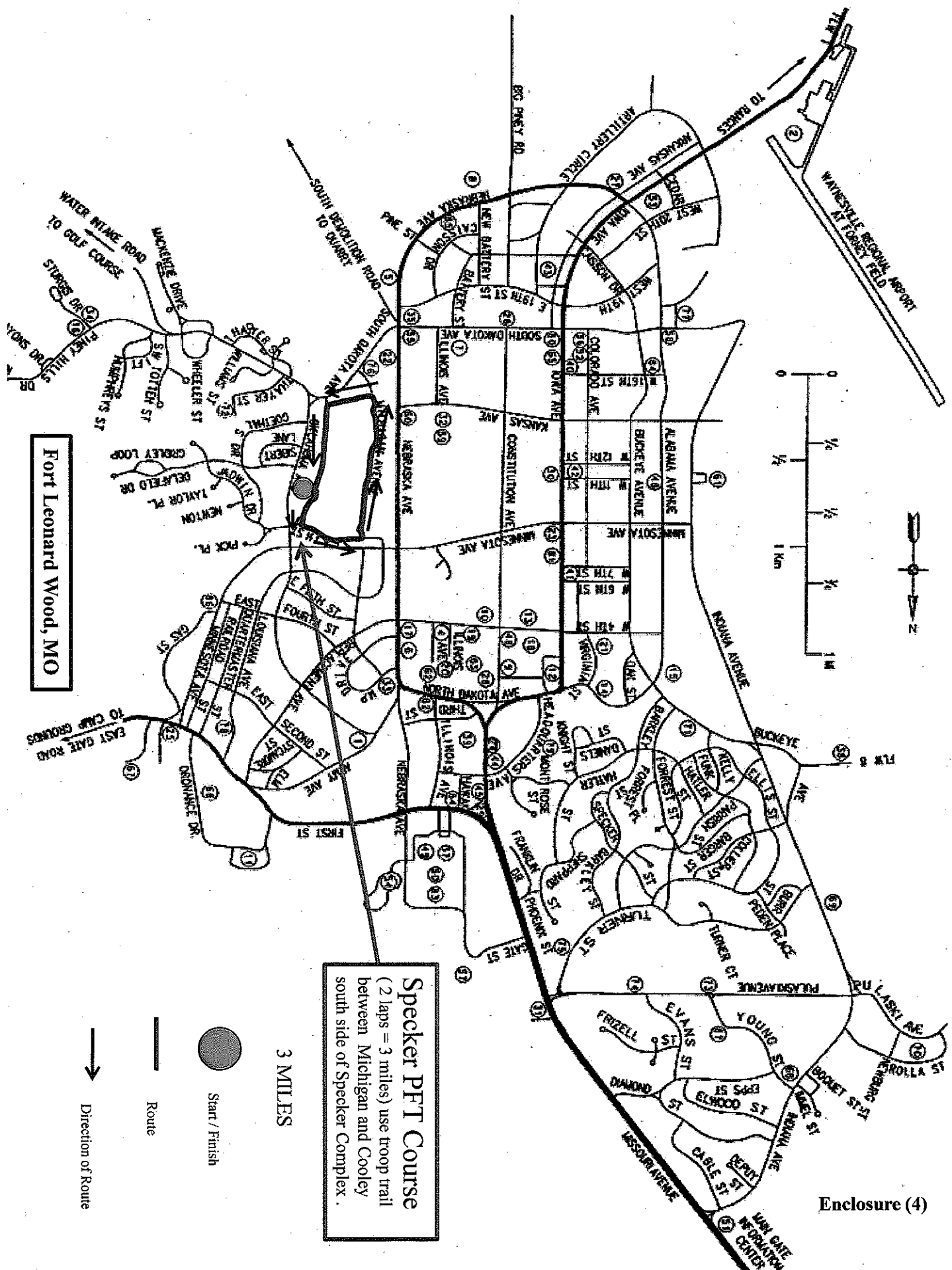
