Military spouses may use the "Military Spouse" Preference for two years from the date of the PCS Orders, after that time, this preference will not work. This applies to both types of federal job appointments, GS/NSPS (Appropriated Funded jobs) and NAF (Non-appropriated funded jobs – which are MWR positions).
