Once completed, please forward to the Academic Chief via email at EEIC. Once the screening is reviewed, the Academics Chief will contact the command and assignments branch to discuss potential and possible instructor duty. The screening is a guide and EEIC will consider waivers to portions of the checklist on a case by case basis.
